Required:

- **A letter of recommendation from a Teacher, Counselor, Pastor, Employer or other unrelated adult who can attest to your character and work ethic.**
- **A copy of your official acceptance letter to a college by **May 5, 2023**. If your letter is not received by that date, your scholarship offer can be rescinded.**
- **Please return your completed application to your school counselor. The deadline for submission is **February 27, 2023**. If you are selected for an interview, you will be notified by your school counselor on or before **March 15, 2023**. The interviews for final selection will be scheduled for the week of **April 10, 2023**. Scholarships will be awarded at your school's honors and awards ceremony.**
- **Scholarship checks will be sent directly to the college during Summer 2023.**
